

Publication Ethics

International Editorial Board, Editors, Reviewers and Publishers follow publication ethics during the whole lifecycle of a paper. We ask our authors to follow them strictly.

The **Authors** guarantee that the paper is original, that it was not previously published or concurrently submitted for publishing to another journal and that the presented results are based on real data achieved by objective methods application. They should acknowledge all sources and avoid any form of plagiarism. In the “Acknowledgements” chapter, they are recommended to provide financial support for the conduct of the research and/or preparation of the paper.

The **Corresponding author** must be familiar with the Acta Facultatis Xylogiae Zvolen (AFXZ) journal’s publication ethics and scope. He/she is solely responsible for communication with the journal and managing communication between the co-authors. He/she ensures that all authors are included in the author list and agree with its order, and that they are aware the manuscript is to be submitted. Any changes related to author names in the authorship list must be approved by the journal Editor, after receiving an e-mail with request send by the corresponding author.

The **Editors** and **International Editorial Board members** are obliged to ensure the fair peer review process of evaluating the scientific quality of the paper submitted. They are obliged to keep a high standard of papers in the journal. They are given responsibility and authority for the final decision to accept/reject a paper. They guarantee that any unpublished information will remain confident and will not be used for other purposes.

The **Reviewers** are obliged objectively to evaluate the scientific quality of the paper submitted. By accepting the review, reviewers declare that there is no conflict of interest with respect to the submitted paper, the authors and/or the research funders. In reviews, they should point out the need to cite current and relevant bibliographical sources. They should treat all content of the whole review process confidentially.
